Boyertown

Cross Country

At the Centaur Invitational Meet in Allentown, the Boyertown cross country teams finished eighth and 15th. The girls led by Izzy Valenti, who placed 27th in a field that had 32 teams, paced the Lady Bears with a 21:31 finish. Steph Skovronski (22:29) finished 50th and Ashley Prestia (22:58) was 62nd. Kathy Malenchek (23:35) and Beth Trout (23:46) finished 87th and 95th respectively to round out the Bears scoring.

Danielle Prestia placed seventh in the Freshman Race with a time of 23:49.

Matt Renninger's 37th place in a time of 17:54 was tops for the Bears. Brandon Foose ran to a 67th finish (18:27) and Craig Geiser (18:36) finished 78th. Brad Anderson (18:49) and Eric Arobone (19:52) completed the boys' scoring.

Earlier in the week, the boys were defeated by Exeter and Wyomissing in a quad-meet, 23-34 and 19-39 respectively. The Bears defeated Holy Name, 20-41. Foose crossed the finish line first for the Bears in 15:27.

The girls met the same fate as Exeter defeated them, 24-31. Wyomissing ran past the Lady Bears, 15-49. The Lady Bears scored a perfect 15 against Holy Name, who scored 50. Valenti covered the course in 18:52 to lead the Boyertown girls' team.

Field Hockey

The Lady Bears field Hockey team was defeated by Wilson, 1-0, in a Berks I fray. A first half goal by the Bulldogs stood up for the entire contest.

Tsakonas got his second touchdown in the fourth period on a 24 yard run. Reish split the uprights with a kick to add the extra point.

The Bears amassed 416 yards on the day, 398 on the ground and 18 in the air.

Golf

Boyertown registered its sixth win of the season, defeating Daniel Boone, 383-398. All the Bears scored in the 70's with Mike Furman leading the way with a 74. Kyle Kolarz turned in a 76 while Rodney Gabel collected 77 strokes. Jordan Grater and Dustin Smale each recorded 78.

To date the Bears have only lost one match.

Soccer

Boyertown (3-1) was awakened by Wilson with a 5-0 defeat. The Bears have regrouped and defeated Reading and Oley Valley recently.

Tied at one apiece, the Bears scored twice against the Red Knights in the second half. Freshman Will Nace got the game-winner with nine minutes to
