## Collegiate update

**Dave D'Aiello**, a junior from Gilbertsville attending Kutztown University, tied the game between the Golden Bears and Molloy, 1-1. KU went on to register a 3-2 season-opener victory.

Bloomsburg University sophomore **Nikki Hartranft**, a graduate of Oley Valley High School, got an assist on the lone field hockey goal as the Huskies lost to Wesley, 2-1.

**Melissa Youse** of Boyertown, a student at Lebanon Valley College, scored the third goal in the 3-0 win over Franklin and Marshall College.

Moravian College captured first place of nine participating schools at the Kutztown University Maroon and Gold Invitational. **Lindsay Stehman** of Gilbertsville, a freshman

harrer at Moravian placed 42nd in a time of 26:22. One hundred and seventeen runners took part.

Boyertown junior **Wes Zimmerman**, who is a member of the mens' cross country team at Moravian College finished 52nd at the Kutztown University Maroon and Gold Invitational with a time of 29:11. The course length is 8,000 meters. One hundred and twelve athletes participated in the meet.

Drexel University junior field hockey forward **Kristina Backenstose** of Barto, leads the Dragons in assists and is

Backenstose started all 20 games last year, scoring 11 goals with five assists to finish third in the conference in goals and was credited with three game-winning goals.

**Monika Rhode**, a junior at Ball State University, is a two-year letter winner and member of the 1999 Mid-American Championship Team. Rhode is a graduate of Oley Valley High School. Rhode has played in 42 games to date in her college career and has started in 35. She has scored four goals for eight career points from her midfield position.

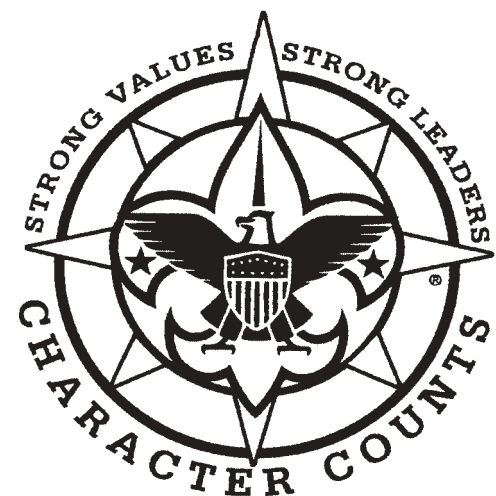

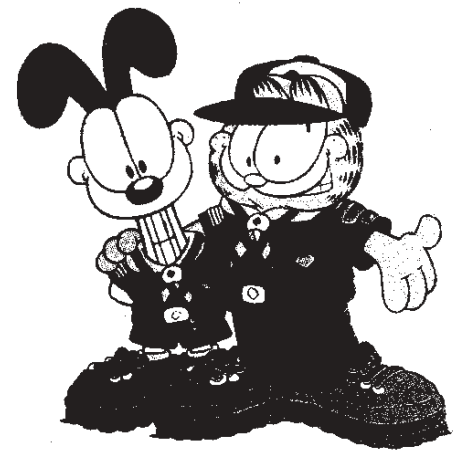
