More dead birds found in MontCo

A total of 14 dead birds have been found in Montgomery County, all infected with the mosquito-borne West Nile Virus.

Five of those birds were found recently in eastern parts of the county.

All of the dead birds have been found in eastern and southern Montgomery County.

With the exception of a blue jay, all of the dead birds have been crows.

Virus experts have said that the disease, deadly to bird populations, is particularly deadly to crows.

Mosquito's are the primary method of spreading the disease. County officials have urged people with standing water to empty the water making it harder for the insects to breed.

Humans can contract the disease as well, also from mosquito bites.
