## Boyertown

### Football

Boyertown (2-1) notched its second win of the season defeating Schuylkill Valley (2-1), 19-12. Eric Reish, a sophomore, threw three TD passes in the first half. He was 10-for-17 for 155 yards.

The Bears running game netted 85 yards on 42 carries in the Intra County game. Because the two teams are in different sections of the league, it is considered a non-league contest.

Reish connected with Ron Mossie twice on passes from 20 and 27 yards out. Ryan Repko caught the other TD pass, which covered 46 yards.

Reish collected half of his completions in the first half, going 5-for-6.

Nate Ottaviani scored both of the Panther touchdowns on miscues by the Bears. Ottaviani recovered a Reish fumble in the end zone for a snap and later recovered a high snap from center for his second TD.

Boyertown mishandled the ball nine times and Schuylkill Valley fumbled five times.

Marc Panepinto rushed 25 times for the Bears and garnered 110 yards. Reish provided the extra points after the Boyertown touchdowns, kicking the pigskin through the uprights.

Boyertown meets Conrad Weiser Friday, September 21 at home. Game time is 7 p.m.

### Field Hockey

The Boyertown High School field hockey team (1-3-1, 1-3-1) suffered two one-goal defeats before playing Hamburg (2-1-2, 3-1-3) to an overtime 0-0 tie.

Jenna Lutz of Exeter (2-2, 3-3) scored on an assist from Kristen Houck at the 16:52 mark of the second half to defeat Boyertown, 1-0.

Samantha Stewart turned away five Exeter shots in goal.

In a similar situation, Governor Mifflin's (2-2, 3-3) Bridget Seidel scored three minutes into the second half and the Mustangs held on for the win.

Goalkeeper Alicia Grater stopped eight of Mifflin's nine shots. The JV unit defeated Mifflin, 4-1.

In an interdivisional game, the Lady Bears and Hawks played three periods of scoreless hockey. Grater saved all nine of the Hamburg shots while the Bears leveled 12 at Hawk goalie Chrissy Harron.

The Boyertown JV squad registered a 2-0 victory over the junior varsity Hawks.

### Golf

The Bears went one up and one down last week on the links. Boyertown (4-2, 7-3) defeated Conrad Weiser (5-1, 5-5), 386-394. Dan Minger shot a 73 to lead the Bears followed by Kyle Kolarz with 75. Mike Furman and Jordan Grater both shot 79 while Keith Thomas rounded out the Bear scoring with an 80.

Wilson (6-0, 10-0) scored a 372-398 win over Boyertown at The Manor Golf Course. Kolarz's 74 was best for the Bears. Grater notched a 77. Dan Minger carded an 80 while teammates Tim Ortlip and Thomas turned in 83 and 84 respectively.

### Soccer

The Boyertown High School boys soccer team (3-1, 5-1) recorded three wins this week with victories over Exeter, 2-1, Hamburg, 5-0, and Governor Mifflin, 5-3.

Mike Rakowski assisted on both goals that spelled defeat for Exeter. Josh Barthel opened the scoring at the 22:11 mark of the first half and Cody Lewandowski scored with 25:26 remaining in the second half to insure the win.

Chad Davis turned away three of Exeter's seven shots.

The JV teams played to a 0-0 deadlock.

Boyertown got two goals in the first half against Mifflin (1-3, 2-4-1) and added three in the second half to earn the 5-3 win. The game was tied at two apiece at the end of the first half. Marc Benson and Scott Kirchner each scored twice with one assist to lead the bear offense.

Kevin Kinkead had two goals against the Hawks (0-4,2-9) as

Skupien and Weller posted the only two wins the Bears would get against Exeter (3-2), winning their matches, 6-3, 6-3 and 6-3, 6-2 respectively.

In a rematch with Hamburg, the Lady Bears fell, 5-2.

Landis got the only singles win, 6-3, 6-1 while Mest and Zimpfer took the first doubles match, 6-2, 6-2.

## Oley Valley

### Field Hockey

The Lady Lynx (5-2-1) posted two wins and a tie last week. In Berks III action, the Oley Valley team defeated Brandywine Heights (1-2-1, 2-3-1), 6-0. In a Berks III encounter, the Lynx defeated Fleetwood, 386-390 at Rich Maiden. Browne was low man for the Lynx with 73. Lydon, Bruder and Ely followed with 77, 78 and 79 respectively. Reider rounded out the Oley Valley scorecard with an 82.

In a tri-match, Oley Valley was defeated by Wyomissing and Kutztown, who scored 428 and 422 respectively while the Lynx turned in a 459. Lydon had the best Oley score with an 85. All other Lynx golfers scored 90 or more.

Schuylkill Valley took the JV match, 2-0.

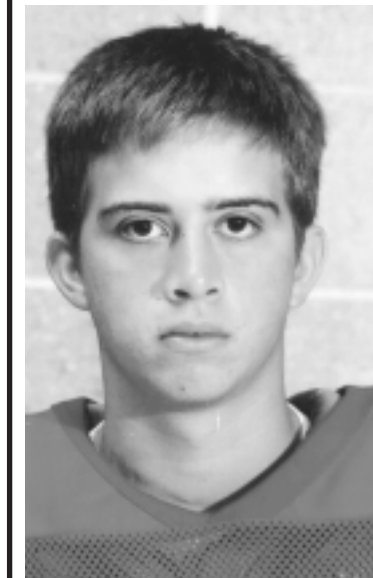
